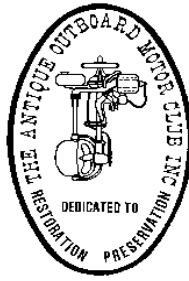


## The Antique Outboard Motor Club Inc.

Canada, and Ontario in particular, wasn't just some minor marketing backwater for outboards. The large number of lakes and popularity of camps, cabins and cottages created a demand that justified the major manufacturers, including OMC (Johnson and Evinrude), Mercury, Chrysler, and McCulloch, to set up manufacturing plants in Ontario.



Not surprisingly, the popularity of outboards here has resulted in the Maple Leaf Chapter being one of the larger chapters, having over 200 members. While members hail from all across Canada, and even the USA, most members and events are located in southern Ontario. We have meets throughout the year, in: January, April, May, September, and October. At these meets, we buy, sell, trade, and run old outboards and sometimes put on technical workshops. The chapter also puts on a number of displays at various shows where the public can view our motors, reminisce and ask questions. In addition, many members get together to organize their own events. Members are also a great source for parts, paint, decals, and information that are otherwise sometimes hard to come by.
